



Improving Disabled Access

After much careful thought and consideration and to comply with current National legislation the PCC of St Swithin's have formulated a plan to improve the access and use of the building by disabled people using wheel chairs and for families with young children with pushchairs or prams.

The plan involves removing two pews to the right of the entrance aisle as you enter the building through the North Porch door and provides a suitable place in which a wheelchair user or family with child in a pushchair could sit without obstructing access. When there are no disabled people or pushchairs the space created would be filled with chairs ensuring no overall loss of seating

The plans were reviewed by English Heritage, The Victorian Society and the Diocese Archaeologist before being submitted for approval and can now be seen on the Church Notice board at the entrance to the carpark and in the North Entrance porch.
